

Call for papers for the 36th Conference of Japan Society for Twin Studies

1. The 36th conference of Japan Society for Twin Studies (JSTS) will be held on the January 22nd of 2022. Although we are not sure how Covid-19 will affect this conference, presentations will be made online through Zoom and directly to the participants in the conference room (i.e., Hybrid-Flexible type). Reports are not limited to behavioral genetics, but all research related to twins is welcome (Medicine, Nursing, Behavioral Science, Neuroscience, etc.).
2. Twin researchers from all over the world are welcome. A potential applicant should submit the entire manuscript by the end of November 2021 to the conference chair Prof. Takafumi Matsuba (Gifu Shotoku Gakuen University). Manuscripts will be peer-reviewed. JSTS will directly make contact about how and when the manuscript be presented at the conference.

Application: Manuscript should be named "JSTS36_yourname.doc" in Microsoft Word Format (e.g., JSTS36_johndoe.doc) and sent to tmatsuba@gifu.shotoku.ac.jp (Note: This is NOT the same with the above conference address). The manuscript should arrive at the office from September 20th to November 30th of 2021, at 21:00 (JST) sharp.
